As we complete another transition from summer to winter recreation, we at the Blaine County Recreation District are humbled by the continuing support of our community: our treasured patrons, over 250 volunteers, more than 50 active partners, and our committed staff. We feel privileged to help meet the need for healthy, active recreational activities in all seasons, and we are so grateful for this generous collective effort every year.

In 2015, we completed some historic milestones. Through challenging winter conditions, we welcomed record numbers of cross country skiers while keeping kids moving every day in after school and fitness programming. As summer approached, we saw record numbers of participants enrolled in day camps, active sports, and aquatics while we completed major recreation trail projects like the Wood River Trail and Galena Summer Trails. Combined, these two projects represent our largest capital investment in community recreation since the inception of the BCRD. With the help of the entire Blaine County community, we have completed over 20 miles of Wood River Trail, 29 miles of Galena single-track, and supported close to six hundred thousand total recreation visits during the year.

The BCRD staff and volunteers strive to make each of these visits meaningful and inspiring, and we are committed to sustainably continuing "down the path" in the future. Thank you for your many contributions. We sincerely appreciate your support of the past year and look forward to the many opportunities to *Pursue the Active Life* in the year ahead.

#### **SPORTS AND LEAGUES:**

The BCRD is proud to provide our community with quality, affordable and fun youth sports and leagues. Be it baseball, soccer or basketball, our participants walk away with knowledge, skills, and most importantly, sportsmanship. In 2015 BCRD saw the following enrollments in each of these programs:

### SUMMER DAY CAMP AND AFTERSCHOOL:

At Summer Day Camp this year we saw a 60% increase over last year's enrollment. 240 kids joined in the fun; with an average of 70 campers per day for 64 days, we saw over 4,480 visits, now that's a lot of kids! From our Kinder campers to the older Challenger group, we pride ourselves in providing diverse opportunities for kids to learn, grow and lead. We continued our successful partnerships with the Hunger Coalition, Higher Ground, Sawtooth Botanical Gardens, ERC and the Animal Shelter of the Wood River Valley in order to teach campers the value of service within our community. In 2015, the BCRD afterschool program saw 7,200 visits. Kids coming to the HUB afterschool engage in fun, quality, play-based afterschool care.







#### AQUATIC CENTER:

The BCRD Aquatic Center is the place to be for summer family fun! With over 21,000 visits this past summer, the pool saw a record number of kids learn to swim and strengthen their water skills. Whether a lap swimmer, a parent looking for a fun outing with kids, or a kid on swim team, the BCRD Aquatic Center is an integral piece of our valley's aquatic opportunities.

A huge shout out goes again to Atkinsons' Market for their continued support! Thank you Atkinsons' for supporting BCRD Swim School, your support brought swim lessons to over 300 kids in 2015!

#### FITWORKS:

BCRD FitWorks continues to provide quality and affordable fitness 12 months of the year. FitWorks had nearly 25,000 visits this past year. A myriad of challenging and engaging classes including boot camp, barre, pilates, yoga and spin brought people from far and wide. Over 1,200 classes were taught equating to over 10,000 class visits throughout the year.


#### **GYMNASIUM:**

The BCRD Gymnasium continues to be a 'one-stop shop' for all things active for our valley's youth and adults. Between organized sports and leagues like basketball and indoor soccer, afterschool open gym, and a variety of weekend tournaments, the Gymnasium had over 56,000 visits in 2015 alone!









## PAVING OMPLETE! WOOD RIVER TRAIL:

Thanks to the community's investment, the 2-year Wood River Trail Reconstruction paving project is now complete. Funded by 2-year county property tax levy, the entire 20-mile path, stretching from Bellevue to north of Ketchum, is now smooth and crack free for all to enjoy! Nearly 15,281 pounds of asphalt were laid over the last two years along this vital artery that connects our valley's towns and provides us with healthy active recreation and transportation.

#### MILES OF SMILES:



#### HARRIMAN TFA:

Over \$16,000 was raised to sustain and maintain the beautiful Harriman Trail at this year's Annual Harriman High Tea. 70 ladies came together at the home of Kristin Owens in support of this north valley treasure. Thank you to all who attended, co-hosted and to Kristin for welcoming all of us into her beautiful home!

#### **SUMMER TRAILINK:**

We made some great improvements to our Summer Trailink website! Now mobile and small screen friendly with new interactive trail maps, updated layout, and more information including elevations, weather and other conditions, KML and GPX files you can use in Google Earth or on your phone/GPS. It is a great tool for getting real time status and finding your way along our valley's amazing trails.





Phase II of the 3-phase Galena Summer Trails project is finished! The new smooth and tacky trails saw a trend of over 10,000 new visits this summer bringing vitality and new life to Galena Lodge in the summer months. Hikers, runners, bikers and equestrians of all ages and abilities came out to enjoy the unmatched quiet, fresh air, and expansive views that these incredible trails offer.

#### PARKING AND SPEED LIMIT:

In collaboration with ITD and the USFS we completed a generous expansion of the Galena Lodge parking lot, worked on slower speed guidelines on the highway in front of the Lodge and posted more pedestrian crossing signs! These much needed improvements are a great step toward increased safety and efficiency around the Lodge.

#### **GALENA BENEFIT:**

The 19th Annual Galena and the Trails Winter Benefit raised close to \$300,000 in support of our beloved Lodge and surrounding Nordic Trails. With an anonymous challenge gift of \$40,000, the 'Stand for Galena' paddle raise brought in a record \$138,500! Thank you to all those who came out, supported, ate, drank, and danced in celebration of Galena and the Trails!

#### **DURRANCE DEMO LOOP:**

Durrance Demo Loop, with its short proximity to Ketchum, sunny aspects, and dog and bike friendly terrain, is back for another winter! We are working with the Forest Service to explore the possibility of making this extremely popular trail a permanent part of the BCRD Nordic trail system.

#### **NEW TOOL CAT:**




